- Givers can readily review a church or ministry's mission and statement of faith.
- Givers can reasonably be expected to have an accurate understanding of what a gift to the organization will accomplish.
- Givers may restrict or designate gifts to particular projects as defined and allowed by the organization within its mission

- **IV.** Givers have the opportunity to give cheerfully without pressure from the organization or its representatives.
- Givers' best interests and future V. well-being will be highly valued by the organization and its representatives when considering potential donations from those givers.
- VI. Givers will receive appropriate and timely gift acknowledgments.

VII. Givers will receive timely and courteous responses to inquiries about finances and

programs.



Givers will be provided a copy of the organization's most recent annual financial statements in a timely manner upon request.

IX. Givers may be granted reasonable and prudent requests to visit the office and project sites of an organization to talk personally with staff representatives.

X. Givers can be confident that the organization is working to ensure its resources are being utilized in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, including biblical mandates, by exercising appropriate management and controls.
